PRINTING NOTES

When printing the seminar overheads under recent versions of Acrobat, you may need to choose a special option if you are using 3 hole punched paper. On the Acrobat print dialog, you should select “FIT” under the size options. This will shrink the page to about 97%, which keeps the text from running over the area where the holes are punched.

The pre-2001 exam files are scanned copies of the exams, so essentially they are nothing but graphics. As such, they also require a printer with a fairly large amount of memory. If you have problems printing the PDF files, please see this web page:
