Location and Hours

No specific location required. Remuneration will be on a per problem basis, so the number of hours needed will vary by candidate.

Qualifications

- Experience with actuarial mathematics content would be expected to be helpful for efficiency.

Compensation

The LaTeX assistant will be paid as an independent contractor of TIA, \$6.50 (or \$10 TIA course credit) per completed problem solution for problem solutions being translated from video, and \$4 (or \$6.50 TIA course credit) per translation of a typed problem statement.

How to Apply

1. Download the overleaf project from <https://www.overleaf.com/read/jydwjzthhsgy>
To do that, click Menu at the upper left of the project screen, and then click the "Source" option to obtain a zip file with all of the project files.
2. Upload this zip file to a new project in your own (free) overleaf account. Set the "main file" to IFM-sample.tex in the overleaf menu.
3. Following the directions in the Instruction.tex file, complete the three typed solutions in the IFM-Sample.tex file using the video solution linked in the comment just before each problem statement.
4. Email me (lee@theinfiniteactuary.com) a link to your completed project (Click "Share" at the top right of the overleaf window to get a link), and include your contact information as well as an estimate of the time that you spent completing the project.
